## Stuck in the Elevator?

Some of you have been asking what to do if you were ever stuck in the elevator. The very bottom button of the control panel is the "Push to Call Help" button. It has an image of the phone receiver to the left of it. Once pushed, the light to the right of it will light up and you will hear a number of tones while the call is placed. After the tones, an operator will answer and ask if you need assistance. The elevator service company is then dispatched and help is on the way. Above the "Push to Call Help" button is an "Alarm" button labeled in red. This button can be used to signal building staff that you are stuck in the elevator. Finally, there are several good numbers to have in your cell phones:

**The Maintenance Pager: (904) 292-6104.**

Call the number, then after you hear the beeps enter your call back number so they can return your call.

**The Security Pager: (904) 292-6103,** works the same way. Don't forget to enter your call back number after the beeps.

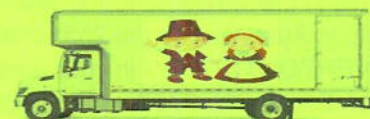
