### Birthstones for October

The Birthstones commonly used for the month of October are fire opal and pink tourmalines or rose zircon.

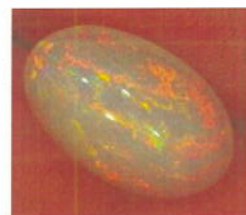
Usually the tourmalines or zircons are used in cases where faceted stones are required.

Fire opals are the most favored choice and the name opal is derived from the Greek word Opallos meaning a change or many colors.

The opal is thought by many to impart hope, purity, and faith to its wearer. It is a fragile gem and is easily chipped or broken. This is probably the basis for the "Bad Luck" superstition for people wearing who were not born in October.

Opals were first discovered in Hungary in a pale blue color, but the gem is found in abundance in its most colorful variations in Australia, and most recently, Ethiopia.
